In Attendance: Chairman, Rhona Klein, Mary Marines - Pennock Insurance, Donna Reeves - DNB First, Joan Dougherty - Henderson Group and Chuck McGroarty - Comfort Home & Hearth

Chuck has offered to collect empty propane tanks at the Recycling Day at no fee. Tanks are to be 20lbs or less. Gas grills or ones for camping.

Responses to Survey: Mary reported that Maryann Furlong should have the responses from the business survey and Maryann will be reporting the results. Joan said that she received back 13 responses out of the 40 surveys sent to her tenants; all that responded said that they are for recycling.

Further discussion on survey will wait until Lynn returns.

Event Update: We have all our vendors.

- Salvation Army for clothes, shoes and sneakers is confirmed per Rhona
- Supreme was approved by the Supervisors for the \$1,250 fee and confirmed per Rhona for anything with a cord.
- Recall for Shredding has been confirmed by Donna and contracts signed by Supervisors.
- Chuck McGroarty confirmed that he will take care of the propane tanks.
- Cell phones - Donna will get boxes from Delaware County for Domestic Abuse or COSA.

Anyone on the committee that has been the contact person with the vendors should make the vendors aware that we would like them to be at the Chadds Ford Township Building at 8:30 am on September 27th to set up.

Volunteers: Everyone on the committee is expected to be at the Recycling Day event to help out. Rhona is sending an email to her neighborhood (Ridings) asking for volunteers. If you know of anyone who could come out to help, please ask - we could use the help. Anyone with contacts with the Boy Scouts in the area - please ask them for help.

Post Cards: Draft of post card designed by Rhona was approved by committee. \$700 budget was suggested and approved by Chadds Ford Township. Maryann Furlong submitted a quote that if the post cards were printed in house, the cost could be kept at \$447 provided the Civic Association postage meter can be used at \$0.14 @. In house printing was approved by the committee.

700 post cards will be mailed. Members of committee will put labels on post cards at a special meeting specifically for that purpose (Rhona will let the committee know when they are ready). Mailing should go out two weeks before the event / September 15th.

Education: Mary will talk with Phil Wenrich about putting a link on Chadds Ford Township website for the recycling event and information on recycling. At the next meeting, we will discuss the next education piece that will be put into the Township Newsletter.

Legislation: Will be based on the results of the two surveys. Discussion will be at the October committee meeting and then results presented to the Supervisors.
